2024 26th Wayne County Men's Amateur Golf Championship



Eligibility

Entry is open to any Male amateur golfer who has reached his 16th birthday by the first day of the championship, is a legal resident of Wayne County, or is a member in good standing of a golf course located in Wayne County. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the Tournament Committee or host club. The reason may include unbecoming conduct or conduct which demeans or is detrimental to the game of golf.

Entries

Each entrant must complete an official entry form on the Wayne County Golf Association website. Entry fee is \$135.00, applications submitted after 7/14 will be charged \$155.00

Format and Divisions

This is a 54 hole Medal Play competition that will be governed by the USGA Rules of Golf. There will be 4 'Divisions'; Open Division, Senior Division, Super Senior Division and Masters Division. The Open Division is open to any eligible entrant regardless of age. The Senior Division is open to eligible entrants ages 50 to 59, Super Senior Division ages 60 to 69, Masters Division 70 and above. All eligible ages are those as of the first day of the tournament.

Practice Rounds

Practice rounds are available at each of the participating golf courses beginning two weeks prior to the start of the tournament. Phone the respective golf courses to make tee time arrangements. Cart fees are required for each practice round (the amount of cart fees will be determined by the individual golf course), range balls will be provided at courses with a range.

Tournament Rounds

Friday 7/26 at Lane Tree GC Saturday 7/27 at Walnut Creek CC Sunday 7/28 at Goldsboro GC
Pairings and starting times will be posted at each of the participating clubs one week prior to the start of the tournament.

Special requests for starting times and pairings for Sunday's final round are not permitted
